DUTY OF CARE STATEMENT

It is our duty to advise you of the following:

Motor Racing can be a dangerous sport and you/or you crew may suffer serious personal injury or death; your car and/or equipment could be damaged or destroyed.

If there is any aspect of a race meeting that causes you concern for your personal safety or for that matter any member of your crew, whether that concern be with the track, the venue, the officials or in the manner in which the meeting is been conducted, then it is your obligation to bring these to the attention of the Clerk of Course.

If after doing this, those concerns not addressed to your satisfaction, you are advised to withdraw from the race meeting. It is the responsibility of the Driver and his/her Crew to understand their obligations and rights in this regard.

It is the Swan Hill Motor Racing Club Inc. duty to advise you that a track official may at a time during a race meeting request a random drug and/or alcohol test. If you have any doubts as to your ability to pass such a test, you should withdraw from the race meeting IMMEDIATELY.

It is the Drivers responsibility to ensure that he/she and their crew behave in a professional manner at all times during the meeting. Any offensive and/or discriminatory behaviour towards officials, competitors, crew, and the general public will not be tolerated and penalties may be enforced.

All officials and volunteers at a race meeting must also be professional at all times. Any offensive and/or discriminatory behaviour towards participants will not be tolerated and penalties may be enforced.

Swan Hill Motor Racing Club Rules and Regulations

Membership prices are as follows:

Driver \$50

Junior Driver \$25

Social membership \$15

Family membership \$70

A family membership covers 2 Adults and 3 children under 16 years of age, with only one senior driver covered. Any additional children under the age of 16 years will cost an extra \$10 each.

All people must pay at the gate to enter the facility on race nights unless they hold a current Gold, Silver, Life Member or complimentary pass. Gate ticket prices are as follows:

Adult \$20

Children (between 10 and 16) \$5

Families \$45

Aged Pensioners \$15

Children under 10 years of age are free.

The Pit levy must be paid by all persons who wish to stay in the pits unless they are a volunteer with a pre-approved job, which they must sign in to or if they hold a current Gold or Life member pass.

Pit Levy \$15

In order to be eligible for a One Day Licence, drivers and passengers must be a member of a club. A social membership is sufficient.

In order for a driver to be eligible for Club racing Points, each driver must be licenced through the Swan Hill Motor Racing Club.

If a driver lives within 100 kilometers of the Swan Hill Motor Racing Club track and is not a member of this club, their nominations may be refused.

Drivers must be a member of the Swan Hill Motor Racing Club in order to be eligible to get their cars day-lighted by any of the clubs scrutineers.

Drivers must attend at least 3 working bee's in order to be eligible for club point scores. Working bee's are held on the Sunday prior to every race meeting, other working bee's will be advised through meeting minutes as well as a text from the club phone.

Two members from each of the classes that race the night before a clean up, will be nominated at each race to attend each clean up day. If those nominated do not attend the clean up days, that class will run the next race with no prize money.

All classes must start the night with 6 cars on the track or they will not receive prize money for the night.

All drivers that are members of the Swan Hill Motor Racing Club must have their own transponders. Club transponders will only be hired to locals twice a season, if the driver has issues with their own.
